

## School supply list for fifth and sixth grade

- Loose-leaf notebook paper only. Daily work cannot be done on spiral notebook paper.
- Plenty of mechanical pencils with extra lead, or #2 wooden pencils (not composite)
- Erasers (large pink ones) purchase extra, they wear out quickly.
- Small basic calculator
- Scissors
- Glue stick
- 2 or 3 good highlighters
- Colored pencils (wood pencils only). No markers.
- 1 plastic ruler (English and metric)
- 2 1 inch, 3 ring binders
- 2 or 3 pocket folders for general use (at least 1 should be plain)
- 1 dictionary- this must be a good one. No “99 cent specials”, please
- Thesaurus
- 1 box of Kleenex
- 1 small pencil box
- 1 12x15x5 plastic container, to fit under the desk. (A cat litter box works great!)
- 1 bible – new living translation (these can be purchased in the office for \$5.00)
- For sixth grade math students, a good quality compass and protractor (the smaller the better). If you aren't sure, see teacher before you purchase one.
- 1 small water bottle with a wide mouth for filling (no more than 20 oz)

Please mark your child's initials on all his/her supplies and check periodically to see that they are replenished. All supplies should be in the classroom by the end of the first week of school.
